Baby Toddler Security

Children's World, with the help of Jewel Lake Parish, was able to update the security system this past month at our Baby Toddler site. We want to thank the parents of this program for their patience and flexibility during this time. It took a lot of cooperation to get this system up and running and we appreciate all of your effort. There is a new front door lock at this site, that will prevent anyone from entering the building without the code, allowing us to ensure that our students are in the safest environment possible. We also updated the security camera system there, allowing us to have the highest quality system to ensure that we can keep our eyes on the little ones!

Summer Movements

With the summer months quickly approaching, Children's World wants everyone to keep their eyes peeled for classroom movement notices!! Summer presents us with the ability to allow a large classroom shift through our programs and we definitely do not want any of the children caught off guard. Children, who are moving, can expect to see a notice starting on May 6th posted at their cubby. We encourage parents to bring their children to their new classroom (especially if it is at a whole new site) multiple times so that they can become familiar with the space, teachers and peers. Administration recommends that a classroom visit usually occurs around 9:00 am, before the morning circle.

Montessori Tip for Home

With Spring finally rooted, it is time to let your little one lead the way. Outdoor nature walks provide wonderful learning and playing opportunities for our children. The sensory experience provided by nature gives the child the opportunity to connect his inner world with the external world. The door to nature needs to be opened to the child little by little. It is the responsibility of the adult to prepare the activities in such a way that they are beneficial for the child. Activities such as watering plants and caring for them, feeding animals and practicing voluntary movements in outdoor environments will foster a deep love and respect for the child's surrounding. Nature has to be more than an exceptional event in a child's life. It must be a part of everyday life.
