Preparing for a new start

Summer is coming to a close and a new school year is right around the corner! For Children's World Bilingual Montessori students and children everywhere, that means it's time to get ready for a new beginning. Whether your student is transitioning to a new classroom or beginning their experience here at CWBM, there are many ways you can help children transition into the classroom setting.

One of the easiest ways to prepare your child for a new school year is to talk with them about what to expect. If this is your child's first time in a school setting, it's important to explain what their experience will be like and answer any questions or address any concerns they may have. If your child is returning to school after summer break, try talking to them about friends and teachers they are looking forward to seeing, as well as other things that they particularly like about school such as their classrooms, playground, and more.

Whether your child is transitioning to a new classroom or a whole new school, unfamiliar settings can be a source of stress for children of all ages. Finding ways to familiarize children with their settings is a great way to eliminate anxiety on the first day of school. Visit the school, if you can; walk them through the front entrance so they can "practice" what their first drop off will be like. These things will go a long way in terms of supporting the child through decreasing the factors of the unknown.

Regularity of routine is extremely important to young children, and it begins from the moment they wake up in the morning. Start to build their concept of what new routines will look like when school begins. Routine is only learned through repetition, so your child will likely have to go through the same patterns a number of times before they start to internalize the fact that they can trust in their environment and in the people, who play prominent roles in their lives.

Independence is at the root of all activities in the Montessori curriculum. Giving your children more independence in their daily tasks is a great way to prepare them for the curriculum in particular. Some places in which to incorporate independence in day to day activities for your children include: eating snacks and meals, getting dressed and cleaning up after themselves.
