Bienvenidos to the 2020 Fall school year! Children's World is excited to be in the classrooms, learning with your children this year. Although school looks a little different, our love of Montessori still stays the same.

Fresh Start

A new school year brings with it an opportunity for growth. Children's World has spent the past few months learning a whole new way to operate during these extraordinary times and we want to say **THANK YOU** for all your cooperation and patience. Children's World has learned so much and grown with all the families that have stuck with us through this time.

We have never felt more confident in our decision on how to operate during the pandemic than now. We have found our rhythm and will continue our stride in keeping our children and staff safe.

For the foreseeable future we will continue with staggered drop off/pick up schedules. Teachers will still receive and dismiss children outside. Our operating hours will continue to be reduced to 7:30 am to 4:30 pm. Classroom sizes will stay at a lower capacity and the increase of disinfecting materials will continue.

Starting the School Year

The first experience in a group setting, without parents, can be both a thrilling and frightening event for some children and their parents. There are many ways that you can help your child feel more confident and relaxed as they begin this new experience.

Make sure he/she can get in and out of their clothes by themselves (for our bigger kids) without any real help from the teachers. For example, pants that are easy to pull up and shoes with Velcro

Fall Material Fee

There has been an increase in the Fall Material Fee (\$175) to compensate for the increase of supplies the school has needed to purchase to keep everyone safe and healthy.

Payments

Payments are due by the 5th of every month. If the 5th falls on a weekend, tuition should be received by that following Tuesday,

instead of laces. Your child is striving for independence and we can foster this by being aware of his/her capabilities and developing skills.

The most important thing during the first few weeks is for the parents not to let any of their anxiety show in front of your child. Children are sensitive to their parents' emotional states and if he/she senses you are anxious, then they may think there is something in this new environment to be anxious about. Be positive and enthusiastic about your child's new classroom and your child will follow your lead. '

Above all else, make sure that if you have any questions, concerns or ideas for how we can support your child's education in our classroom, please let us know. Our goal as educators is to set each child up for success and to assist them into journey in life.
