Reminders

Break Up Season means cold mornings and warm afternoons. Do not forget the puddles that are going to be appearing everywhere. Please remember to dress your child appropriately to address all the seasonal changes for the month of April.

Health Policies require that any child who presents or develops a temperature of 100°F at school must remain home for a minimum of 72 hours. Excessive coughing, mucus secretion, vomiting and diarrhea will also require a child to stay home for 72 hours.

Timeliness for pick up and drop offs are necessary. If you need to drop off/pick up outside your scheduled time, please just contact Administration and it will be approved. Failure to contact the office will result in Late Pickup Fees.
